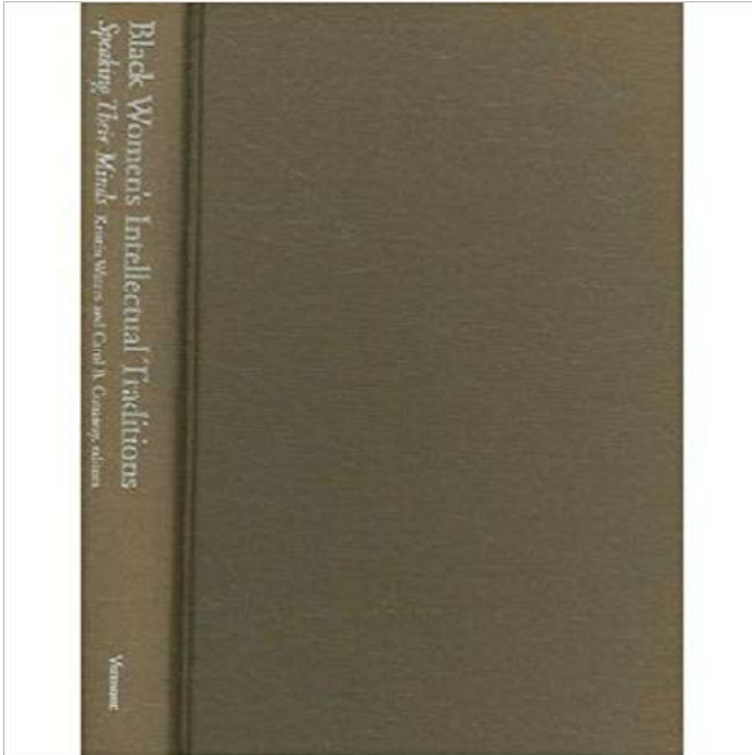


Black Womens Intellectual Traditions: Speaking Their Minds
