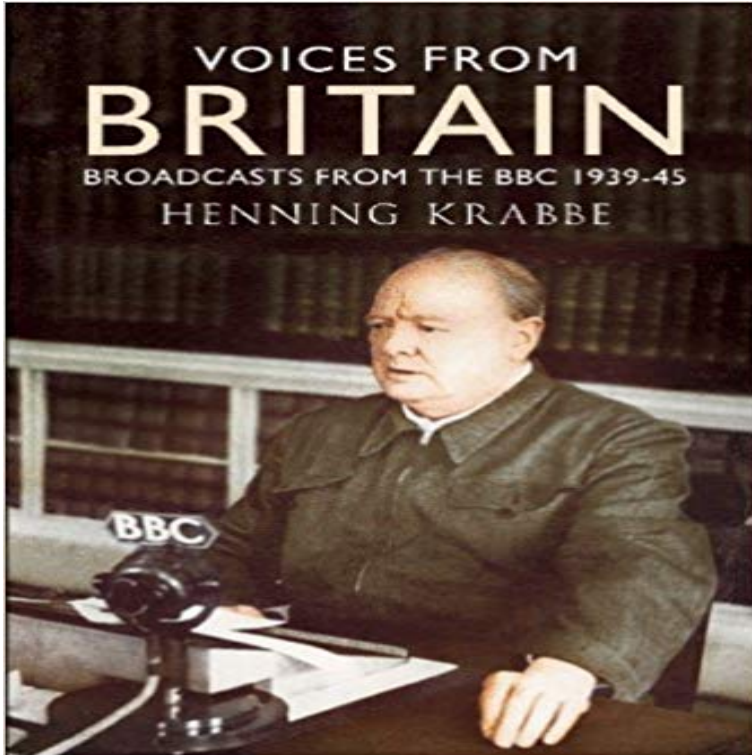


## Voices from Britain: Broadcasts from the BBC 1939-45
