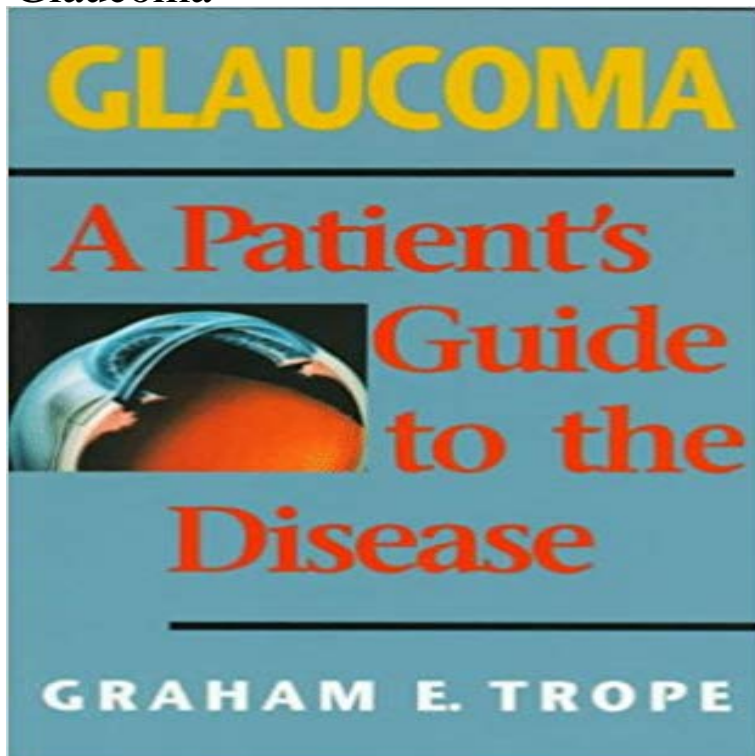


## Glaucoma
