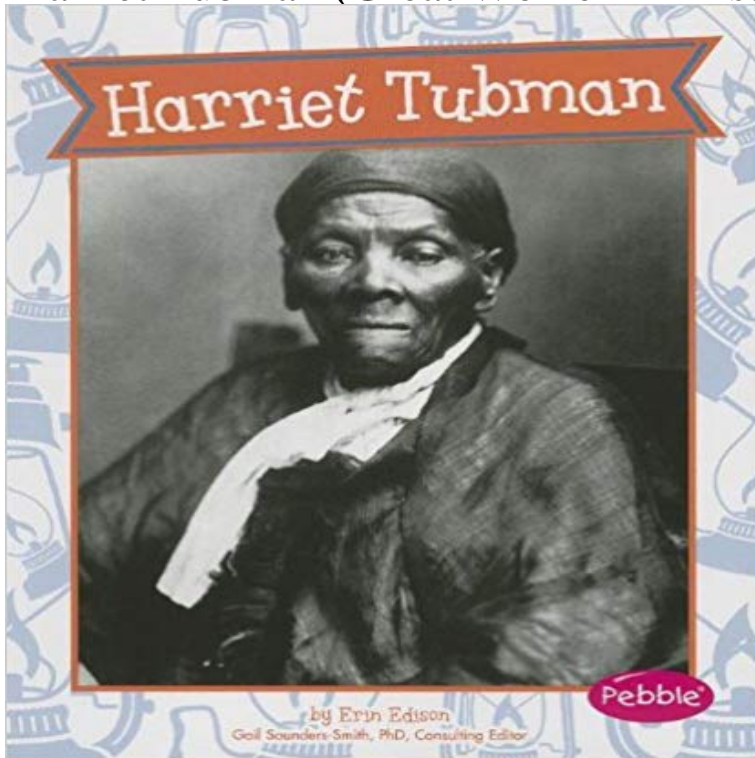


Harriet Tubman (Great Women in History)
