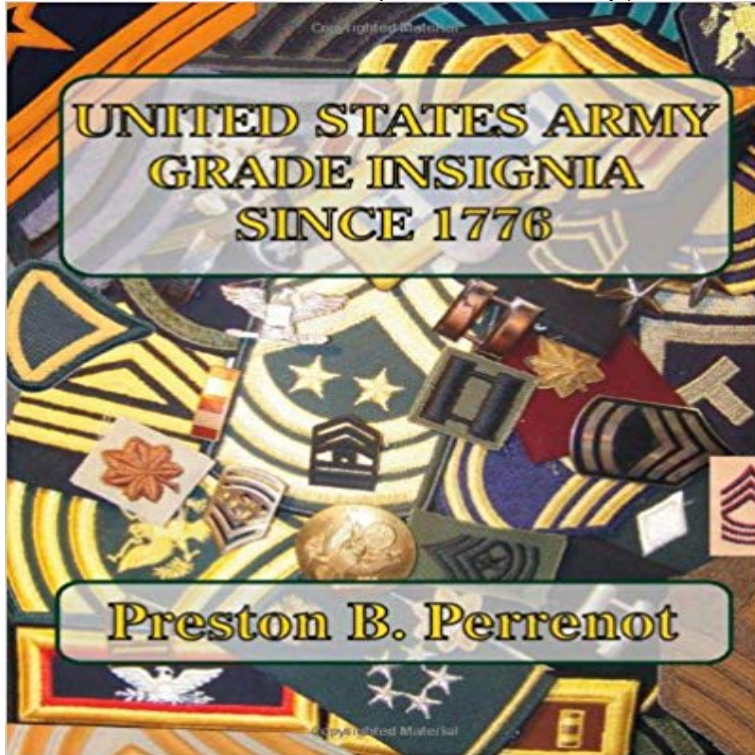


United States Army Grade Insignia Since 1776
