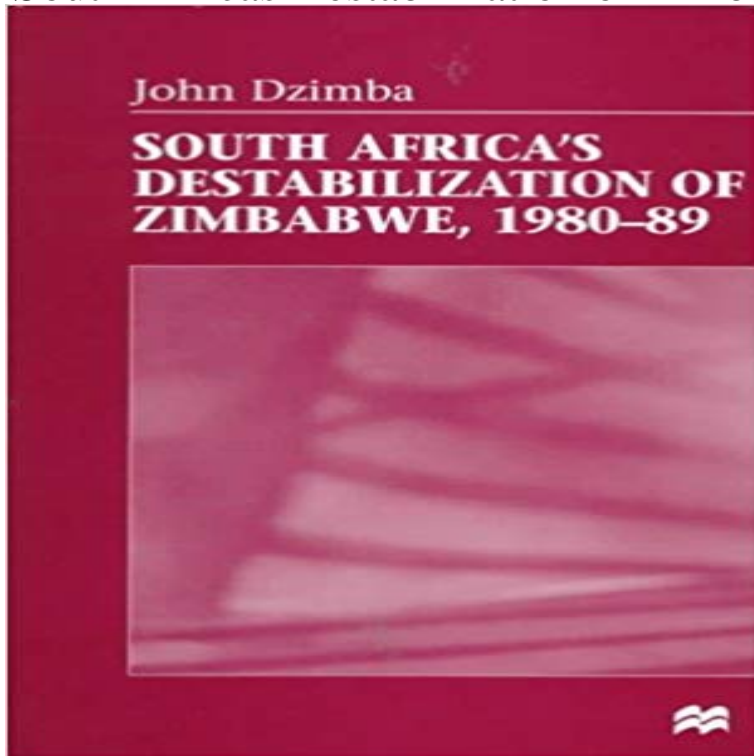


South Africas Destabilization of Zimbabwe, 1980-89
