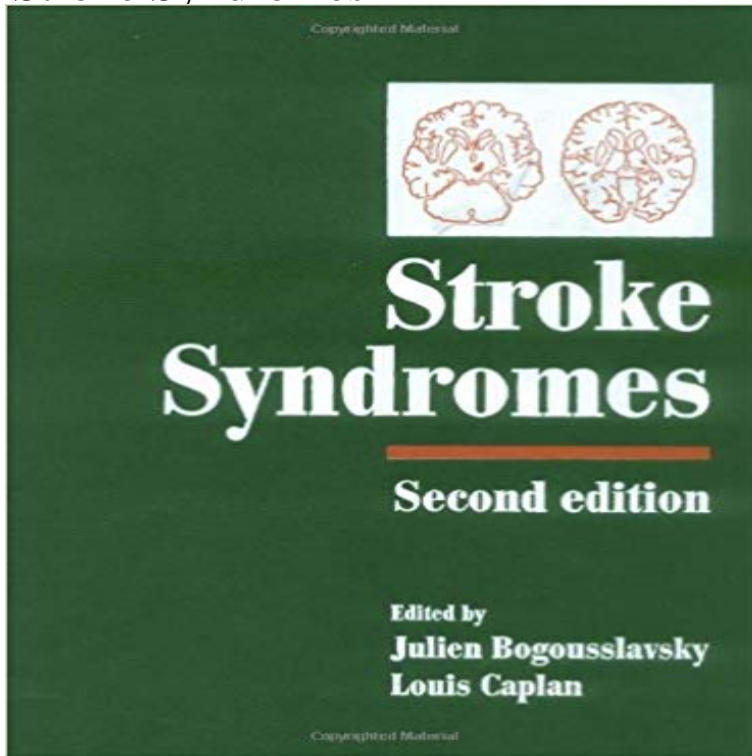


Stroke Syndromes
