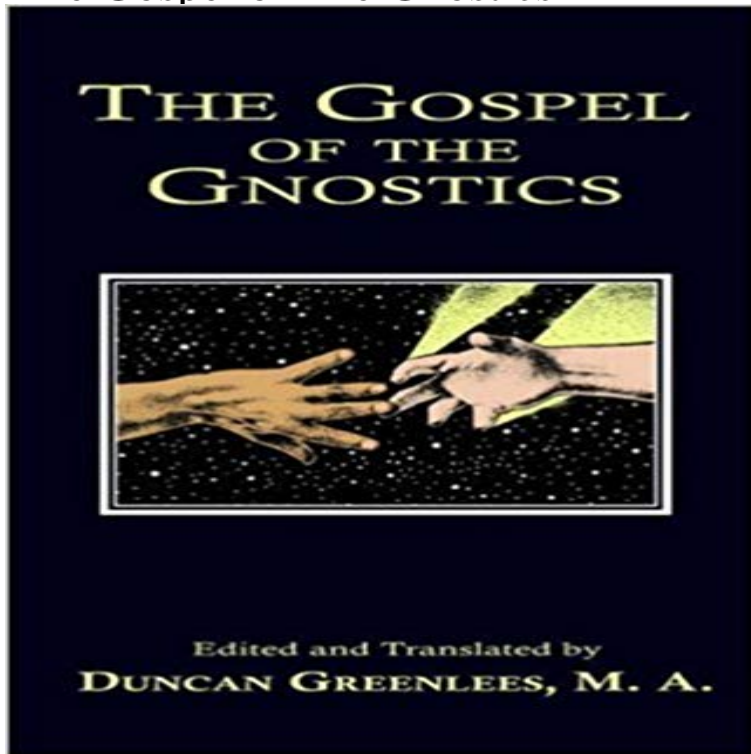


The Gospel of The Gnostics
