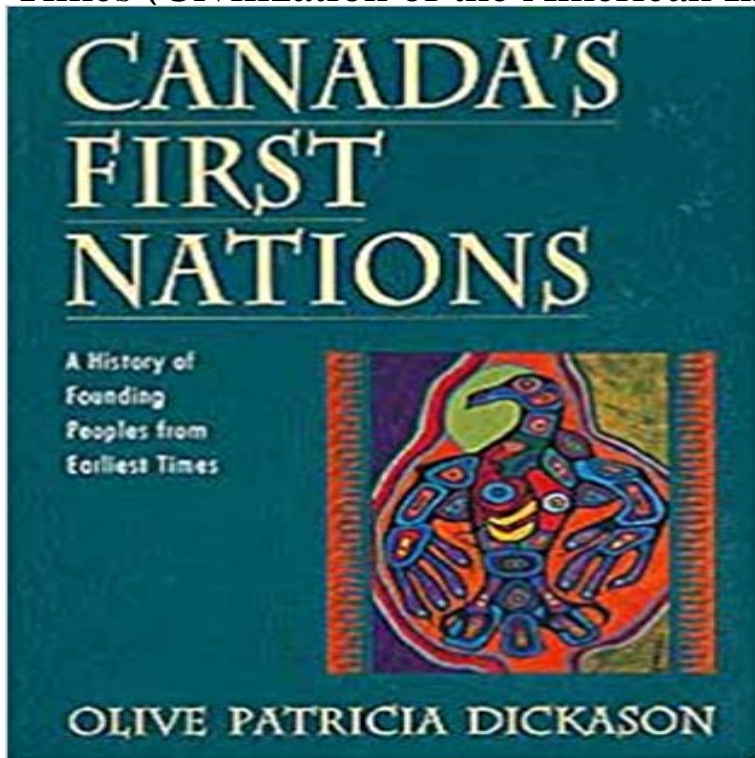


Canadas First Nations: A History of Founding Peoples from Earliest Times (Civilization of the American Indian)
