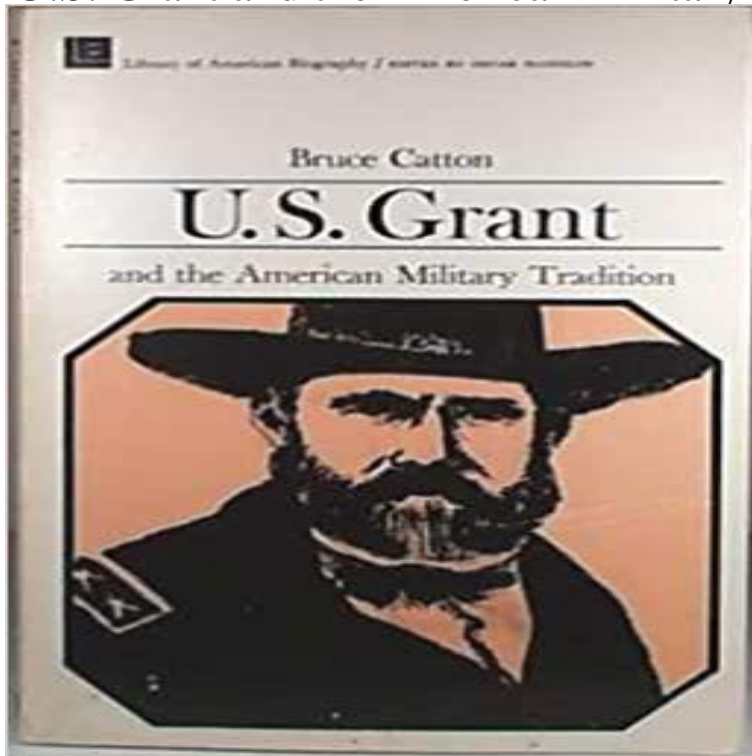


U.S. Grant and the American Military Tradition.

Beginning with Ulysses S. Grants youth in Ohio and his service as a young lieutenant under General Zachary Taylor in the Mexican-American War, the story continues through Grants postwar disgrace, his forced resignation for drinking, and his failures as a citizen farmer and salesman. But after the Civil War broke out, Grant rose from the rank of an unknown soldier to commanding general of the US Army, finding redemption as the military savior of the embattled Union. Proving his reputation as Americas premiere expert on the Civil War, Catton examines Grants campaigns in enthralling detail, including Fort Henry; Shiloh; the Siege of Vicksburg, which set the Confederate enemy on the inevitable road to defeat; and Robert E. Lees surrender at Appomattox Court House, which solidified Grant as a figure of national acclaim. Catton then explores Grants two-term presidency and final years, casting an illuminating new light on a complex and controversial national figure whose great accomplishments have all too often been downplayed or overlooked.
